OVERVIEW

Workplace safety is the responsibility of everyone in an organisation including person in non-profit organisation. Companies have legal obligations to meet certain safety requirements, but many go further than the basic obligations. Safety standards and procedures must be put in place, and everyone needs to follow the standards in order for them to be effective.
